Q3. Family physician/ general practitioner with a specified special focus to practice.

Nationally: Among family physicians/general practitioners with a special focus to their practice, the most frequently indicated foci were: Emergency medicine (24.1%), Geriatric medicine (8.8%), Obstetrics (8.5%), Palliative care (6.5%), Anesthesiology (5.2%), Psychiatry (3.9%), Psychotherapy (3.4%), Addiction medicine (3.2%), Occupational medicine (3.2%), Sports medicine (3.2%), Hospitalist care (3.2%).
