Q25b. Please indicate if there are other important access issues for your patients.

Among all Other Clinical Specialists (excluding Internal Clinical Specialists): Twenty-four percent of respondents indicated other important access issues for their patients when given the opportunity. The issues most often indicated include: the shortage of family physicians, the shortage of hospital beds, psychiatric services for children, lack of universal drug coverage.
